On 16th of May onwards, a cricket tournament was organized jointly by JLMS teachers and staffs which lasted for three days. There were four strong teams who had participated, namely, Raru Band Of Brothers, Surley Mayur, Hotch Potch(JLMS teachers & staffs team) and JLMS students team. After the one on one league matches, regarding the standing points. Hotch Potch took on Raru Band Of Brothers for the Final match. And there we enjoyed 2 days and 1 night to refresh ourselves after long months of studies. Everybody felt happy by having the most favorite dishes, the hottest tea and the coolest juices. No doubt, in that evening, eve-

rybody were jumping and making the dance moves to every musical tracks.

HIMALAYAN MEDICAL CARE ARRIVED AT JLMS:-----

On 12th August, like last year, the same group of Himalayan Medical Care arrived at school ground and checked medically and medicated all the students and near-by villagers who were contracted to any serious diseases and ailments without any cost.

MR. BERND AND THE GROUP ARRIVED:-----

Mr. Bernd Balaschus, the founder of this wonderful school (JLMS) arrived at school on 8th of August with a group of Shambala Charitable Trust members. All the students, teachers and staffs gave him and his group a warm reception traditionally carrying white scarf, flowers and copper- made kettle filled with drinks. He and his group stayed for 11 days at Raru camping site and met with every JLMS family members followed by a short get together among the teaching staffs and hold a brief conversation.

14TH FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY & B'DAY OF THE FOUNDER:---

14th founding anniversary and the happy birthday of Mr. Bernd Balaschus were extremely well observed together on 14th of August, the most special day. The day began with religious gathering and prayers before the Manjushri at the school stupa for the well being of human kinds and things like that. Then with gracious presence of the Chief Guest Mr. Bernd the founder of JLMS, distinguished members of Shambala Charitable Trust, Chairperson Mr. Tenzin Gelek and other guests, the speaker Mr. Karma Namgyal, the assistance Head- Master commenced the function with a welcome note to all the guests and viewers. Then he announced the forth-coming inter-house march pass competition which consists of three contingents, namely, school team, Kailash house and Ngari house followed by some speeches delivered by Head-master Mr Karma Rinchen Phuntsok, Mr. Bernd and the Chairperson Mr. Stanzin Gelek and the next was calisthenics display exercised by 165 to 170 students with different formations. At the end of the morning session, we had a large varieties of cultural programmes like Ladakhi, English and Hindi dances as well as songs with cool refreshment for everyone. After the recess, class-wise exhibition was uncovered comprising the subjects like Buddhism, local foods and beverages, Zanskari crafts, Zanskari costumes and nomadic life of Zanskar which was replete with colorful articles and complete descriptions. Like that the joyous day came to an end with academic prize distribution for those distinct students who had done exceptionally well in examinations.

INDIAN INDEPENDENCE DAY:-----

As preceding years, the school also participated in morning march pass and

cultural show at Padum on 15th August to mark the 62nd Independence day.

ARRIVAL OF H.H. THE 14TH DALAI LAMA IN THE VALLEY:-----

Regarding the entreaty applied by Zanskar Buddhist Association, H.H. The 14th Dalai Lama arrived in Zanskar valley to bless every audiences on 17th August. Meanwhile school remained closed for a week as summer break. All the students with parents and teachers and staffs attended the lively religious discourse delivered by His Holiness. The teaching lasted for five days and everybody returned back after a warm see-off for His Holiness.

VOLUNTEERS FROM GERMANY:-----

Two German under-graduate students were here to teach students voluntarily for nearly 2 weeks. One was Mr Andre Gudenrath and Miss Anna Hillebrand who acquired new experiences with the new kind of school and pupils. They left the school in the 2nd week of September by Raru to Darcha trek route. On 28th Sept, another German girl under-graduate student Miss Lynn Kliger came here and taught students till the end of the session 2009-10. With her newer approach and technique remained very handy for students as well as teachers. She also returned back by the same route taken by the former two volunteers.

TEACHERS' DAY:-----

Likewise, the preceding years, the second teachers' day was marked on 5th September. Children from each and every classes, one by one, invited every teachers and served a brief tea party and entertained with songs and dances. At around 8pm in the late evening, the eldest class invited every staffs and teachers for the grand dinner party in the staff room which was concluded with jolly full of various songs and varieties of steps of dances. After all, staffs and teachers enjoyed the way students initiatively celebrated and marked a milestone to continue for the years to come.

CHILDREN'S DAY:-----

Although the actual date falls on 14th November the day which comes some days after the school closes for Winter vacation. But the school observed Children's Day on 2nd October which is the great day, Gandhi Jayanti as an adjustment. Each and every class teachers arranged tea party and some cool refreshments plus gave away some gifts for each and every respective pupils after a brief morning get-together. In the evening, all the children were amused to watch funny skits, sweet songs and all time hit music and dances performed by teachers as a treat for the day.

WORKSHOP OF SNOW LEOPARD CONSERVATION GROUP:-----

On 6th October, like last year, a snow leopard conservation group were here to held a workshop on the subject wildlife of Ladakh an Zanskar valley which are endangered and left uncared. The workshop was also more onto the subjects like flora and fauna, birds and other wildlife inhabited in Ladakh and Zanskar region. Their main messages were to maintain ecological balances and to conserve wildlife of Ladakh and Zanskar valley. They even came up with varieties of games related to the above mentioned subjects. Students from class VI to VIII participated in the eventful workshop.

TERMINAL EXAMINATION:-----

Last year's final term examination, which weighed 40 marks, out of a cent marks, for each subject was successfully conducted on 17th October. Marks obtained in the examination were added with the marks scored in 3 internal unit tests and the 2nd terminal examination which they had appeared earlier.

ANNUAL RESULT DECLARATION:-----

On 2nd November, annual academic result was declared within the presence of all the students, teachers and the respective parents as a concluding event of the session 2009-10. The school pass percentage was 94.68%. Among 203 students who had appeared in the examination, only 10 students were failed.

After that, every student's academic report cards and text-book for the next session were distributed. Then, within a short period of time, every body left the school for their respective villages and silence echoed by the valley.



**AN INTERVIEW WITH MR.. LOBZANG TASHI, PRESIDENT OF
LUNGNAG YOUTH ASSOCIATION STUDENTS' WING JAMMU
AND EX- STUDENT OF THIS INSTITUTION, PRESENTLY
TEACHER OF JAMYANG-LING MODEL MIDDLE SCHOOL.**

THE CALL : Jullay, Tashi Khamzang .

TASHI : Jullay, Tashi Delek .

THE CALL : First of all, when did you admit in the school?

TASHI : First of all I would like to convey my heartiest thanks for interviewing me and giving me a chance to express something in school magazine " THE CALL" .

I was admitted on 6 July, 1994 and luckily I was a first batch student of J.L.M.S.

THE CALL : Can you please recall to say something about the school and your attitude during that very fresh moment?

TASHI : In that very fresh moment, I was so happy to go to the school. That time I didn't know what is the meaning of school. In the same time there were one or two teachers in the school. The teachers taught us very well and gradually, I got a sense of knowledge .

THE CALL : You had been studied in this school for about nine long years, so share with us briefly about your schooling right from lower class till class eight.

TASHI : In these nine years, I got a very good foundation and I was very fortunate to get a proper education. I met with well educated teachers and I didn't had to face any problem and I had no problems for Board-examination with the help of very good teachers and that teachers were very friendly and I would never forget their kindness. After class eight I went to Jammu and I got admitted in K.N.I.T. school.

THE CALL : How did you feel about the K.N.I.T where you had been for your higher classes and the hostel you lived in?

TASHI : K.N.I.T. is too good because in K.N.I.T., the teachers are very well educated ,well experienced and they all are very friendly behavior, if there is a problem, they support us very well. The teachers care us time to time. There is an attractive hostel, where all the children live.

There are separate rooms for every four children.
In the hostel we get everything, what we needed.

THE CALL : What differences you experienced between your stay at Jammu and your temporary job in J.L.M.S?

TASHI : In J.L.M.S. I am a temporary teacher. I have very proud feeling and fortunate too that the place where I teach, is a place where I studied. But in Jammu I got more experience compared to JLMS. Because there is too much facilities for the students. JLMS is a small town and Jammu is a big city, but I studied in JLMS, so I prefer JLMS for my temporary job .

THE CALL : Can you make some suggestions for the up-liftment of this school in the future?

TASHI : My suggestions for the upliftment of this school for the future. All the managing committee members should co-operate with the teachers and the headmaster ought to cooperate with the parents and students. The main upliftment is to be unified in the society and co-operative with one another.

THE CALL : Through this magazine, what messages you wanted to give the whole family of J.L.M.S?

TASHI : Dear J.L.M.S. family members, We are very lucky to get a chance to work in J.L.M.S. by the grace of Shambala Charitable Trust of Germany. So on behalf of Lungnak Youth Assosiation Students' Wing Jammu. I would like to say, thank you for your kindness, and perennial treatment for the Zanskar. I want to pass this message for our brothers and sisters so to use your time judiciously during schooling.

The world will become a better place only when we shoulder our responsibilities properly. Responsibility is all about performing one's duties sincerely. Teach your child to be responsible from childhood because they are the citizens of tomorrow .

SINCERITY :- One essential quality one should developed from childhood, without which it becomes very difficult for a person to become honest and upright in life, is sincerity. Sincerity means a whole hearted approach in doing anything and everything. Teach your child to be sincere.
